What is the Happy OU Project?

The Happy OU Project is a federally funded
CCAMPIS (Childcare Access Means Parents in
School) Grant from the U.S. Dept of Education
received by faculty at the Jeanine Rainbolt
College of Education.

Who is eligible?

- Full-time undergraduate students who are eligible for Pell Grants, or qualify for public assistance.
- Graduate students who qualify for public assistance.
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Have a child or children ranging in age from before birth -5th grade.
- Student enrolled in a degree or certificate program at OU Norman or OU Tulsa. (OUHSC does not qualify)
- Students who maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher
- Education majors will have a priority.



This grant allows qualifying student parents to receive a childcare subsidy (full or partial tuition coverage) for OU's Institute of Child Development (ICD- ages 6 weeks to 4 years), or a qualifying Before/After Care program for school-age children.

We also provide academic, student and family services through OU and other community partnerships.
