## Steps:

1. Select the background image first.
2. Then go to File
3. Select Place Embedded
4. Select the image of woman in pink coat
5. Select the layers for both the images and name them by double clicking on the layer
6. The layer with the woman's photo should be placed first and layer of the background image should come second
7. Now select Transparency from the above bars.
8. Set it to 25%. This way you will see your image's position in the background.

9. Now go to Select and click Subject
10. Keep transparency at 100 now
11. Go to View on the top right side. Drop down the menu and choose Black and White
12. Now to refine the image, go to Global Refinements, keep Smooth bar at 33, Contrast bar at 5 and Shift Edge at 10
13. Go to Onion skin again
14. Press Ok
15. Save the picture

## Steps

1. Select the background image first.
2. Then go to File
3. Select Place Embedded
4. Select the image of the girl
5. Select the layers for both the images and name them by double clicking on the layer
6. The layer with the woman's photo should be placed first and layer of the background image should come second
7. Now select Transparency from the above bars.
8. Set it to 25%. This way you will see your image's position in the background.

9. Now go to Select
10. Click Select and Mask
11. Now keep transparency at 90
12. Near Transparency bar drop down the View menu
13. Select Black &White from there
14. Click 'Zoom in' two times
15. Go to Global Refinement
16. Keep Smooth at 50 and Contrast at 30.
17. Now, go to Onion skin Mode from the Drop-down menu in View
18. Save picture now
